Meeting was called to order by Chairman, Jack Pugh, at 8:15 a.m.


Roll was called with the following responses: Pugh, present; Howell absent; and Been present. County Clerk, Deena Farrow, present.

**Adjourn:** A motion was made by Pugh and seconded by Been to adjourn meeting. The motion was approved with the following votes: All aye.




