

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
MCINTOSH COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
December 15, 2025

The McIntosh County Board of Commissioners met in a meeting on Monday, December 15, 2025, at 8:00 a.m. at the McIntosh County Criminal Justice Center. Chairman, Dean Taylor; Vice-Chairman, Clifford McElhaney; and County Clerk, Deena Farrow were all present. The motion was approved with the following votes: all aye. Noted that bid received from Steve Asphalt, but no written bids received. After the meeting, ADA Stidham refused to approve Youngman Asphalt bid altogether due to non-conforming notary (stamped signature), and approved Souter bid notary as conforming.



- G. A discussion was held regarding possible county question to renew current sales tax expiring 2026.


6. Reports


